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CURRAN PARK HISTORY

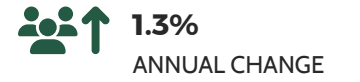
Curran Park is a gathering place for residents of the village of Curran.

Investments have been made in recent years to improve the park, including the installation of flagpoles and the expansion of the parking lot.



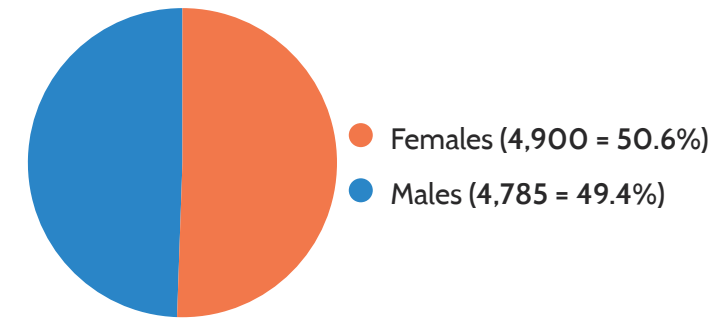

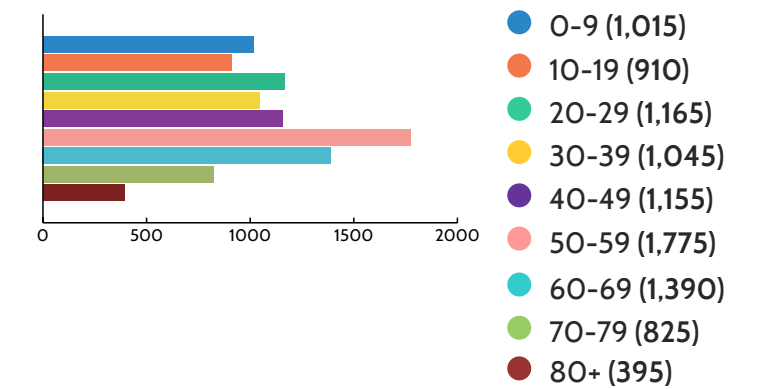

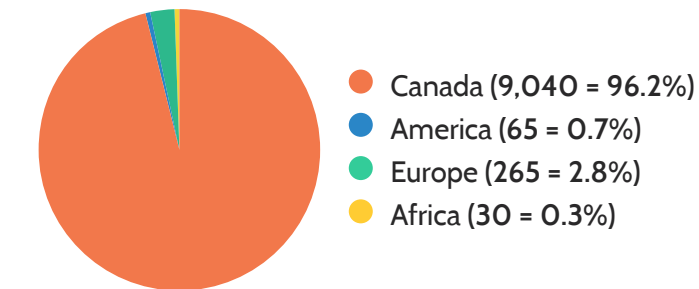
GENDER



AGE DISTRIBUTION

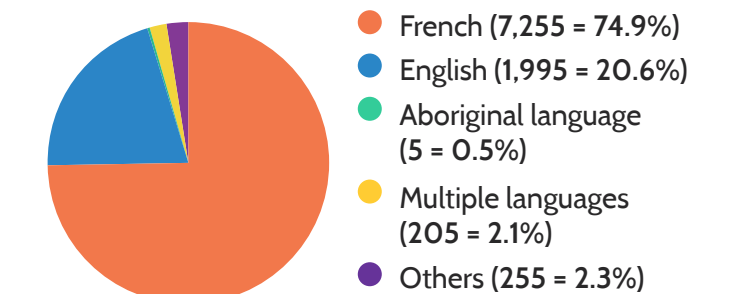


COUNTRY OF BIRTH

ABOUT THE PROJECT AND HOW WE WILL GET THERE

Curran Park is perceived as a community and event space. It is frequently used by residents and by visitors to the Curran market, which takes place every summer.

The Alliance-Curran group has identified three major projects that could take place in this park over the next few years. Funding for these projects will come from several sources, including:

1. Public partnership contributions.
2. Commercial advertising space.

Project evaluated in 2022

CREATION OF A WALKING TRAIL AND AN ICE RINK IN WINTER

The proposed all-purpose path would run alongside the trees at the end of the plot, forming a loop so that people could walk long distances safely through the park. The path would have a width of 3 metres. In winter, the multi-use path would be converted into an ice trail, enabling people to enjoy a skate tour of their neighbourhood.

PROJECT VALUED AT: \$10,000.00

EXPANSION OF THE LIBRARY

To maximize the usefulness of the infrastructure, an extension to the library is proposed. This extension would provide toilets accessible from the park, a small multi-purpose room for the sale of products at the Curran Market or for storage, and an outdoor shelter to enable people to watch the skating rink, the children's games, or the trail while staying out of the sun or rain.

PROJECT VALUED AT: \$200,000.00



Project evaluated in 2022

INSTALLATION OF BASKETBALL, PICKLEBALL, AND PETANQUE COURTS

The proposed basketball and pickleball court would accommodate a greater number of residents of different age groups. In addition, the Alliance-Curran committee is proposing to install a pétanque court.

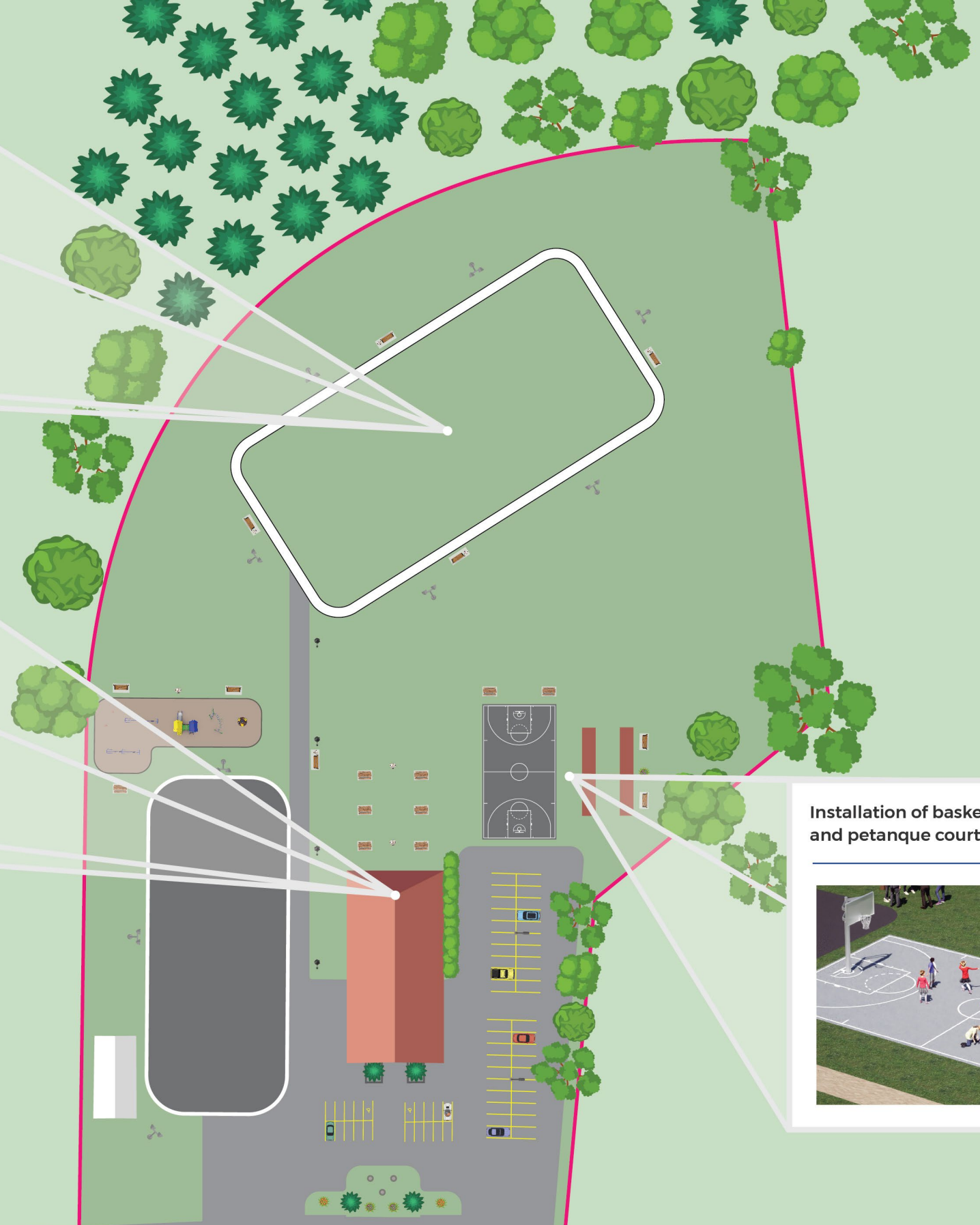
